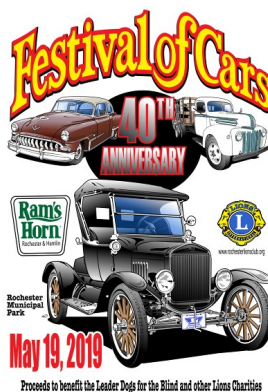

Who are these great looking Lions (and friend)! Found this posted at Dining in the Dark which was held by Leader Dog at the MGM Grand. The event raised \$200,185.



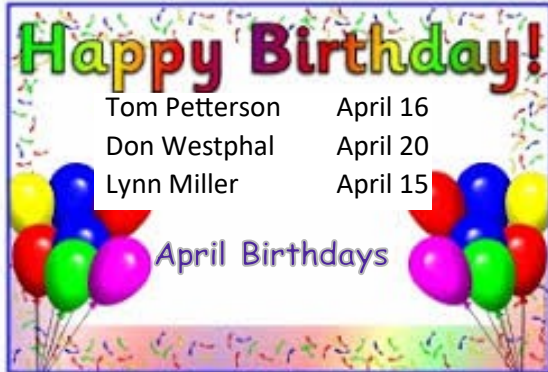
Our Car Shows are coming soon! We will need everyone's help to make these events a success! Sign up sheets are going around at every meeting. Sign-up early and often!
