Welcome to the 29th year of the Festival of Cars, sponsored by the Lions Club of Rochester. There are other events in the park that day, such as the 31st Rochester Area Heritage Festival and the Rochester Fire Department demonstrations.

The Rochester Lions Club was founded in Rochester in 1944 and is celebrating its 64th anniversary this year. Service to the blind has been one of Lionisms most significant activities. Lions volunteer their time to raise funds for eye banks, cornea transplants, research, training, rehabilitation for the blind and research into treatments for diabetic retinopathy — the leading cause of blindness in developed nations — and other causes such as relief for flood, earthquake and tornado victims.

Here, in Rochester, we have Leader Dogs for the Blind®, a school dedicated to pairing blind students with highly trained dogs. All proceeds from this show will be donated to Leader Dogs for the Blind®.

This year our Master of Ceremonies will once again be “Top Hat” John (John Jos. Jendza III), who is a well-known local specialty automotive historian/writer, car collector enthusiast and automobile appraiser. “THJ” will provide his usual colorful commentary with owner interviews and automotive history factoids.

We hope that each participant of this show, all who attend, and all the volunteers know they are reaching out and touching others' lives and helping make the Rochester Lions Club's motto “We Serve,” come true.

We will have hot dogs, coffee, cold drinks, etc. available at the show.

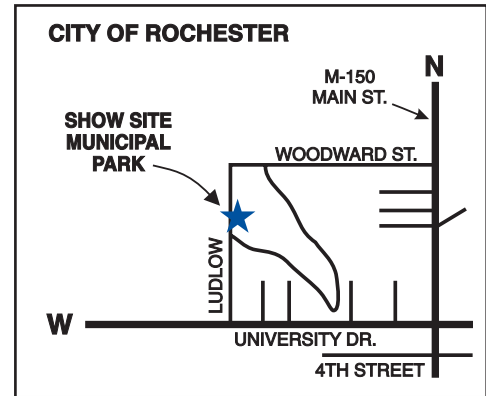
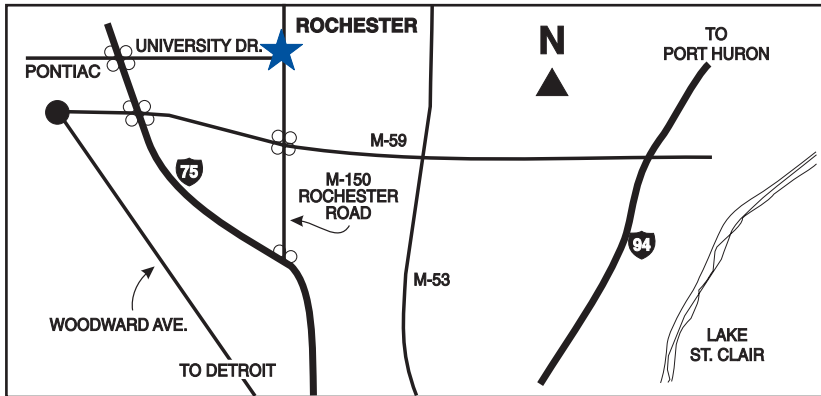
