The March regular meeting included Lion Barbara Zonca giving a presentation about diabetes. Lion Barbara is on the Diabetic Education Committee with Henry Ford Hospital. There are 36 million diabetics in the United States. There are two types of diabetes. Type 1 which has no cure and requires daily injections of insulin and Type 2 which can be controlled with diet, exercise, and meds. Henry Ford has developed a Bionic Pancreas for Type 1. The Bionic Pancreas provides automatic insulin dosages which reduces carb counting and manual insulin calculations.
